MATHS

We use the White Rose Scheme of work and we follow the small steps of learning these are the small steps we will cover this half term.

Y1

- Subtraction - finding the difference
- Comparing addition and subtraction statements $a + b > c$
- Comparing addition and subtraction statements $a + b > c + d$
- Recognise and name 3-D shapes
- Sort 3-D shapes
- Recognise and name 2-D shapes
- Sort 2-D shapes

Y2

- Fact families - addition and subtraction bonds to 20
- Check calculations
- Compare number sentences
- Related facts
- Bonds to 100 (tens)
- Add and subtract 1s
- 10 more and 10 less
- Add and subtract 10s
- Add a 2-digit and 1-digit number - crossing ten
- Subtract a 1-digit number from a 2-digit number - crossing ten
- Add two 2-digit numbers - not crossing ten - add ones and add tens
- Add two 2-digit numbers - crossing ten - add ones and add tens
- Subtract a 2-digit number from a 2-digit number - not crossing ten
- Subtract a 2-digit number from a 2-digit number - crossing ten - subtract ones and tens
- Bonds to 100 (tens and ones)
- Add three 1-digit numbers

English

This half term, we focussing our writing around the Polar Express. We will cover different genre of writing such as letters, story, instructional and information texts. Phonics sessions will be taught daily along with spelling rules and punctuation and grammar.
