These are priced at £1 minimum donation.

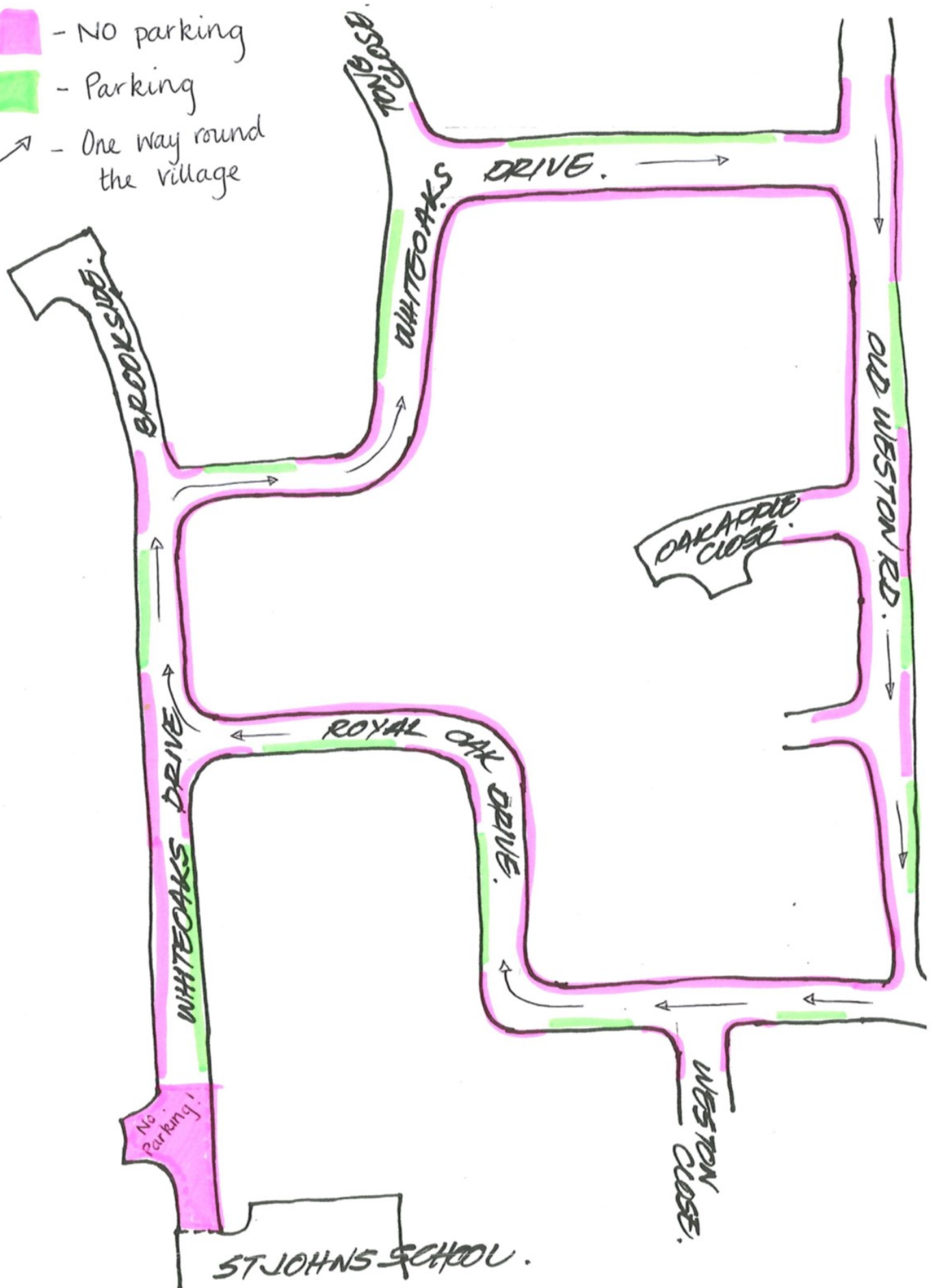

Flu Vaccines



On Thursday 17th November the School's Nursing Team will be on site administering the Flu Nasal Sprays to children. Permission details have been sent out from school via email.

These go straight to the nursing team to either give or deny consent.

Please read carefully, especially if your child is asthmatic.

Please can I remind you we are a healthy school:

- children should only bring water in their bottles unless prearranged with their teachers.
- We are a nut free school.
- We are happy for children to bring a small treat as part of their lunch such as a kitkat or something similar, but children should not be bringing sweets and lollies in their lunch box.
- Snacks for play time should be healthy such as fruit, cereal bars, plain pop corn etc.

Oaks Class do not qualify for free fruit at break times. We can not guarantee we will always have enough to provide them with it..

Please send them with a snack if required.
